# **Communicating** with Skype for Business



Skype for Business is a communication tool that lets you easily send messages, voice and video call and even see each other's screens.

#### Use it for:

- Daily hui (meetings): as a team or oneone; you can even record meetings!
- Talking socially and building whanaungatanga (connectedness) using video can help your team feel connected
- Quick pātai (questions)
- Sharing screens to see what you are working on

Actively include everyone if you are meeting via Skype. Pause regularly and check if participants want to add something, let them use video, voice or text.

# **Collaborating** with Microsoft Teams



MS Teams is a chat-based collaboration space, where your team can work together on documents, share information, team files and calendars. You also have access to the Skype message, call and video chat functions from within Teams.

#### Use it for:

- Communicating pānui (updates) which reduces emails
- Asking for feedback and advice from the team
- Collaborating on documents
- An easy place to access your team plan
